Packing List

You may use the packing list on the Glen Brook website as a guide. Please follow the recommendations for foot ware. You should have **boots** that are fully waterproof, as well as sturdy **shoes/sneakers** that you don't mind working in. Please also have a **raincoat** or good quality poncho with a **hood**. And please have a sturdy **watch** as well as a small battery **alarm clock**. As a group we are officially off of Glen Brook Time, and are very much on Real Time! You do not want to rely on anyone else for where you need to be!

Laundry

CITs are expected to use the laundry service which the campers use. This is an overnight service which will be paid for by the camp for you. It is important that you use this service and not the laundry machines at camp.

Electronics

Here are the electronics you may bring this summer:

- A) personal music listening device
This means that you may not bring external speakers.

- B) camera
Please do not plan on taking any videos.

- C) cell phone
This is for minimal use only.

There are rules for these items which we will go over once you are here.

There are now new rules for all of Glen Brook regarding **laptops**: Laptop computers must stay home. This applies to all counselors as well as CITs. There will be one laptop available in the office for counselors and CITs to check their e-mail.
