CIT and Parent Agreements, Permissions and Releases

I have read the letter to CITs and Parents and the page of Expectations, Rules, and Understandings. I agree to the conditions, responsibilities, and rules expected of CITs at Camp Glen Brook for the camp season:

To Parents:

We strive to give the CITs the kinds of responsibilities and privileges we believe most students their age might have. However, we also attempt to recognize and to respect the differences of opinion from family to family. Therefore, we ask you to check off the following types of situations that can occur at camp. We assume that the CIT has permission to do the full range of camp activities, however do you also approve of your child:

- Walking a mile into Marlborough on occasion to get pizza or go to the grocery store? Yes No
- Spending a few hours in Keene or another town with peers on a day off? Yes No
- Going with peers to a movie in town or renting a movie video occasionally? Yes No

(Note: Because of the broad spectrum of adult situations in R- and "Un"-rated movies and because of varying family guidelines, it is camp policy that CITs not view R-rated movies at camp.)

I further grant the following permissions and releases to Camp Glen Brook for the summer program:

I hereby give permission to Camp Glen Brook to provide ongoing health care, to select medical personnel, and to order x-rays or routine tests or treatment for my child during the time my child is a camper. In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection and/or anesthesia and/or surgery for my child. I understand that this release may be photocopied or electronically transmitted for use away from camp.

I hereby give permission for my child's full participation in all general camp and CIT activities and programs including, but not limited to the following: archery, games and sports, swimming, outdoor skills and nature study, animal care and gardening, work projects including kitchen and general maintenance, confidence / challenge ropes course, canoeing, kayaking and boating, arts and crafts, bicycling, hiking, backpacking, camping and other general camp activities. Further, I know of no reason, including those of physical or emotional health, to preclude my child's full participation in all camp programs and activities.

I understand that camp programs and activities carry risks of accidents that may result in injury and losses. I release Camp Glen Brook, its employees, and its agents from responsibility or legal liability for any injuries or losses to my child unless determined to have been directly caused by the gross negligence or malfeasance on the part of Camp Glen Brook, its employees, or its agents.

I give the camp director, or a person whom he appoints, permission to inspect all personal belongings brought to camp by my child or sent to my child while at camp. I understand that any items that the director deems unsafe, unacceptable, or inappropriate to the best interests of the camp will be shipped home at my expense.

Media images or recordings of my child made by or authorized by the camp will become camp property and may be used by Camp Glen Brook for brochures, videos, website, print, or other publicity purposes. Directory information may be compiled and distributed for the private use of campers and staff.
