



Summer Camp Tuition Payment and Refund Policies

A deposit of \$1,000 must accompany each camper's application.*

If you are sending a check we must receive it within one week of your child's application date to confirm your child's enrollment. Please note that there is a percentage based processing fee charged for credit card payments. **DEPOSITS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**

*Note: If applying for campership, a deposit is only required after assistance awards have been made

Remaining Tuition is due on or before April 1st. Failure to meet this payment deadline can result in cancellation of enrollment.

If applying after April 1st, the full balance is due with your application.

If you need financial aid - Please fill out an online Summer Camp Application. Then fill out a Campership Assistance Application (glenbrook.org/campership) and submit it with the required documentation. Camperships will be awarded on a rolling basis as space and funds allow.

Refund Policy

YES: If you cancel before April 1st you will receive a refund of tuition paid less the non-refundable deposit.

YES: If your child must leave camp due to serious health issues or a family emergency you will receive a prorated refund of up to 50% after the non-refundable deposit.

NO: If your child is dismissed from Camp for behavioral reasons (including, but not limited to, any violation of our code of conduct), arrives late, voluntarily withdraws, or cancels after April 1st there is no refund.

We recommend purchasing camp tuition insurance.
